MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP STORMWATER
MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE (NO. 3 OF 2010) BY REPEALING SECTION 1001
ENTITLED FINANCIAL GUARANTEE AND SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) OF
ARTICLE X ENTITLED MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES AND RENUMBERING
SECTION 1002 TO SECTION 1001 ENTITLED MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES
AND 1003 TO SECTION 1002 ENTITLED MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR
PRIVATELY OWNED STORMWATER FACILITIES**

The Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors do hereby amend its Stormwater Management Ordinance as follows:

- (1) Section 1001, entitled Financial Guarantee, Subsections (A) and (B) of Article X- Maintenance Responsibilities, is REPEALED in its entirety as the Board of Supervisors no longer require financial guarantees for the timely installation and proper construction of stormwater management controls within Mifflin Township.
- (2) Section 1002 of Article X, entitled Maintenance Responsibilities, is AMENDED by renumbering it to Section 1001, and renumbering Section 1003 of Article X, entitled Maintenance Responsibilities, to Section 1002.
- (3) Ordinance No. 3 of 2010 entitled “Municipality Stormwater Management Ordinance” (adopted on December 29, 2010) is further AMENDED throughout the Ordinance so that any reference to:
 - (1) The previous Section 1002 entitled Maintenance Responsibilities shall be referenced as Section 1001, Maintenance Responsibilities.
 - (2) The previous Section 1003 entitled Maintenance Agreement for Privately Owned Stormwater Facilities shall be referenced as Section 1002.
 - (3) Financial guarantee(s) and the original Section 1001, entitled Financial Guarantee and Subsection (A) and (B) are repealed.

These amendments are severable. If any provisions or their application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of these amendments and the Municipality Stormwater Management Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application.

All other ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed by the adoption of these amendments. The remaining sections of the Municipality Stormwater Management Ordinance shall remain the same unchanged, except as otherwise amended herein.

These amendments shall take effect ten days following their date of adoption.
